Year 5 - Autumn 1

I know the multiplication and division facts for all times tables up to 12×12

By the end of this half term, children should know the following facts. The aim is for them to recall these facts instantly.

Key Vocabulary

What is 8 multiplied by 6?

What is 7 times 4?

What is 81 divided by 9?

What is the product of 5 and 7?

They should be able to answer these questions in any order, including missing number questions e.g. $6 \times \bigcirc = 42$ or $\bigcirc \div 8 = 4$

Top Tips

The secret to success is practising little and often. Use time wisely. Can you practise these Fluency Facts while walking to school or during a car journey? You do not need to practise them all at once; perhaps you could have a fact of the day. If you would like more ideas, please speak to your child's teacher.
